Grades 7 – 12 Uniform Policies and Guidelines

September 2017

NTCS is a uniform school and all students are expected to support their school by wearing their uniform properly at all times. Students who consistently ignore the uniform guidelines will lose the privileges of casual days and face possible suspension. Uniform items are to be purchased only from R.J. McCarthy Ltd. All items must be crested with NTCS logo only.

Uniform Policies

- **Students must arrive at and depart from school in proper uniform.** *Exception: in cold weather, girls may wear pants to and from school, but must change to the kilt immediately upon arrival to or just prior to departing from the school. Also, students may put on the school tie and dress shoes immediately upon arriving at the school. (Ties and dress shoes may be left in student lockers at the end of the previous day).*
- Students are expected to be in uniform on all school days, unless otherwise notified.
- **The student's name should be written on all uniform clothing in case of loss.**
- Students should have enough items of clothing so as to always have clean clothes to wear. Please ensure that enough items are purchased so that your child is never without a proper uniform set.
- Parents may not excuse students from the uniform policy. Notes from home are not accepted. In exceptional circumstances, the school should be contacted or the student should, upon arrival to the school, report to the office.
- **Field trips:** Students are required to travel on field trips in proper uniform. Under special circumstances, the Principal may grant an exemption.
- **Non-uniform items are forbidden at all times.** This includes lunch time, spares, before and after school. Sweatshirts, running shoes and jackets are to be left in lockers. Dress shoes are to be worn over the lunch hour and during spares.
- **Students may be asked to leave class and/or return home if not in compliance with the uniform policies and guidelines.**

Physical Education Uniform Guidelines

Students are expected to be in the NTCS gym shirt, shorts, white sport socks and non-scuff running shoes. NTCS track suits are also acceptable. All athletic clothing must be purchased at the school and must be maintained in good condition. Students not in complete uniform will be barred from participating with negative consequences for their grade. It is strongly recommended that students have at least two shirts so that one is always available while the other is being washed. All PE items must have the NTCS logo only. Please ensure that all PE uniform items are labelled with the student's name and grade.

Uniform Guidelines - Mandatory uniform items for grades 7-12

Shoes:	Black dress shoes (no white soles) that cover the entire foot (with or without laces and in good repair). No boots, athletic wear, moccasins, deck shoes, open-toed shoes, sandals or sneakers that look like dress shoes.
Shirts:	Oxford (mandatory) and polo shirts must be worn tucked in at all times (including after school). The exception to this is the girl's French cut blouse. NTCS crested shirts only. This includes the Oxford dress shirt (long and short-sleeved), polo shirt (long and short-sleeved). Any undershirts or undergarments must be <u>white</u> in colour so as not to show through the shirt. Undershirts with large logos or slogan must not be worn. Long-sleeved Oxford shirt and tie <u>are required</u> for picture day and other special school functions.
Pants:	Boys only, worn at the waist. Charcoal grey, men's pleated dress pants from the uniform supplier only. No alteration is allowed to change the style , i.e. no narrowing of pant legs.
Tall Kilt:	Girls only, worn so that the tall kilt is 5 cm from the top of the knee cap . A special extra tall length kilt is now available upon request by special order.
Pullover and Vest:	NTCS crested sweaters only. This includes the pullover sweater and sleeveless vest. Navy colour. You must purchase at least one of these items . No other outerwear (sweatshirts, jackets, etc...) may be worn in the school at anytime.
Tie:	It must be worn only with the Oxford shirt and done up to cover the top button.
Belt:	Boys must have a solid, dark coloured leather belt, unmarked, and with a plain buckle to complete the uniform.
Socks (Boys):	Dress socks must be navy, black or dark grey in colour and <u>above</u> the ankle. Low-cut athletic socks are not permitted.
Socks (Girls):	Black, green or navy knee high socks. Black, green or navy tights or nylons. Tights and nylons may not be patterned and no flesh tone colours for nylons. No leggings. Tights or nylons are required for musical performances .
Hats:	Hats may not be worn inside the school building.
Earrings:	Girls only and on the ears only. Please avoid multiple piercings.
Hair:	Any hair colouring must be of a natural hair colour. (Something you could be born with!) Boys must have their hair cut "short" to be off the collar. Boys may not have hair in a ponytail.

Please note: A student who has forgotten one item (e.g. tie, shoes, or socks) may be exempted for the day, but this is considered a uniform infraction. Students with multiple infractions will be disciplined or in severe cases suspended from school. Parents may **not** excuse students from compliance with uniform policies.

Items that are lost or damaged beyond repair or those that your child has outgrown must be replaced. Please ensure that your child is never without a proper uniform set.
