NOTES TO PARENTS

By enrolling your child(ren) in the NTCS Aquatics Program, you agree to the following in order to help us maintain a safe and pleasant environment for all involved in the swimming program.

- Change room policy – Children 5 years and older are not permitted to enter the change room of the opposite sex, either to change themselves or to assist a sibling. Parents may never enter the change room of the opposite sex.
- It is very important that you supervise your children at all times, particularly those who are waiting for their lessons or brothers and sisters that come with swimmers. Please ensure that your children are with you and do not remain unattended.
- During the hours designated for swimming lessons the gym is not available to parents or children.
- We would also ask you to refrain from eating and/or drinking in the hallways, the change rooms and the pool viewing area.
- No credits or refunds will be given once a session has started. If you do need to cancel your registration, it must be done at least one week prior to the start of the session.
- No videotaping or still photography of the pool area is permitted at any time.

NTCS AQUATICS WINTER 2016/17 INSTRUCTOR COURSE

Red Cross Water Safety Instructor (WSI) Course

This course will allow successful candidates the opportunity to instruct the Red Cross Swim Program. Qualified instructors may have the opportunity to work for local parks and recreation departments, private clubs, schools or summer camps, including NTCS Aquatics and Camp Ke-Mon-Oya.

Course Breakdown: The Red Cross WSI Course has 3 components.

1. In-class and in-pool: 24 hours of instruction at NTCS in the classroom and pool
2. Online modules: Online modules are assigned to candidates after the first in-class session. Candidates have 2 months to complete the online portion before resuming in-class on February 11
3. Practicum: Candidates are required to co-teach 8 hours of lessons at the NTCS pool during the Winter Swim Session. Candidates will co-teach the weeks of January 9th through January 30th one day per week (either Tuesday, Friday or Saturday).

Prerequisites: 15 years old by the last day of the course (February 25 2017), and completed Emergency First Aid (this is obtained with Bronze Medallion Certification).

Practicum: Completion of this course requires students to assist in teaching 8 hours (3 full class days) of Red Cross swim classes at the NTCS pool in the Winter 2017 session. The course instructor will negotiate the 3 dates with each candidate. Classes start the week of January 9th and end the week of February 27th.
