#### NTCS Aquatics - Spring 2024 Bronze Medallion & Bronze Cross Course Information

#### **BRONZE MEDALLION + Emergency First Aid CPR B**

**Bronze Medallion** teaches young and adult lifesavers alike how to respond in complex water rescue situations. Bronze Medallion develops physical fitness, decision-making, and judgment skills. Rescuers learn both tows and carries and release methods in preparation for challenging rescues of increased risk. Lifesavers develop stroke efficiency and endurance in a timed swim. Bronze Medallion is a prerequisite for all advanced lifesaving awards.

We require a minimum of 6 students to offer this course. Total course time is 26 hours. This course includes certification in Emergency First Aid (EFA).

→ Bronze Medallion candidates must be **13 years of age** by the end of the course.

**Emergency First Aid** provides a general knowledge of first aid principles and the emergency treatment of injuries including: victim assessment, CPR, choking, and appropriate responses for external bleeding, heart attack, stroke, wounds, and burns. A written test is required for certification in EFA. The cost for writing the test once is included in the course; a second attempt, if the student fails, will cost an additional \$25.00.

#### **BRONZE CROSS**

**Bronze Cross** is designed for lifesavers who want the challenge of more advanced training, including an introduction to safe supervision in aquatic facilities. Bronze Cross teaches the difference between lifesaving and lifeguarding, the principles of emergency procedures, teamwork, and use of special equipment. Bronze Cross is a prerequisite for lifeguard training in the National Lifeguard (NL) program.

We require a minimum of 6 students to offer this course. Total course time is 26 hours.
